About the Forum

Hydro Power Producers in Satluj, Beas, Chenab, Ravi and Pabbar Basins have joined together and have formed a Forum to cooperate under a “**Five Point Programme**” as hereunder to achieve common goals and objectives for harnessing the hydro-electric potential of Satluj, Beas, Chenab, Ravi and Pabbar Basins in Himachal Pradesh in eco-friendly manner and to ensure the development of the area including the welfare of the people. Members have resolved: -

1. To join efforts to pursue the goal of eco-friendly energy development and to evolve integrated Catchment Area Treatment Plan for the Satluj, Beas, Chenab, Ravi and Pabbar Basins.
2. To join hands for comprehensive planning of operations of power stations in the Satluj, Beas, Chenab, Ravi and Pabbar Basins for unhindered operation, optimized utilization of run-off and to pool the expertise to tackle eventualities of operation outages due to floods or mishaps to achieve reliable energy for the people of India for a sustainable economic growth.
3. To create, upgrade and share facilities to generate data in respect of discharge, silt & meteorological observations and share/utilize common Laboratory testing facilities.
4. To jointly develop and implement effective flood forewarning and disaster management systems.
5. To share views and derive common approach towards implementation of guidelines and statutes of State/Union Government and forward constructive suggestions for modifications/improvements.
